PSMA November data update highlights:

- **CadLite** – the Other Territories dataset now has Norfolk Island Cadastre data included for the first time.
- **Transport & topography** – contains a significant upgrade to the data model for the transport (roads) theme. Edge matching will have been significantly improved over the August 2011 release. The Other Territories dataset now has Norfolk Island Road Centreline data included for the first time.
- **G-NAF** – there has been a significant reduction in the number of addresses contributed by Australia Post nationally (around 430k). The change is a result of a significant data improvement program which included removing phantom address from their dataset. Additionally users should expect an overall improvement in other G-NAF data quality measures. Plus other issues have also been addressed in this release.
- **Land Tenure** – addition of QLD Tenure information. The Dataset now includes: SA, NT, VIC, ACT, and QLD.
- **FOI** – As additional data becomes available new feature types are being added into the features of interest schema.
